

GREETER DUTIES

Please read before serving as a Greeter.

- 1) Be at church 30 minutes before the service begins.
- 2) Put your name tag on. The usher's desk is located in the hall to the right of the door to by the kitchenette. You will find a "greeter" badge to put on your name tag.
- 3) Please stand between the WELCOME CENTER and the wall where the picture of the crucifixion is hung.
- 4) ***Greeters are the first faces that people see coming into church on Sunday!!!! Your job is therefore very important.***
- 5) Please greet people as they come into church. Introduce yourself to people that you don't know. We have many new members and visitors. If you don't know personally know someone, please introduce yourselves to them.
- 6) If the people are visiting, help them with a name tag. There are paper nametags in the box under the WELCOME CENTER. Have them ready.
- 7) Assist people as needed with finding their way in the building. Show visitors with children where the worship bags and nursery are located. Make sure that they know that children are **welcome** in worship!!
- 8) Your whole family is encouraged to serve together.
- 9) Please stay in place until the service begins. The ushers will take over greeting latecomers once the service has started.
- 10) Thank you for being an ambassador of our church as we gather for worship and study.

If you are not able to be present for the service that you are scheduled for, please find a replacement or notify you Saints in Service Team Leader.
